This volunteer position requires the ability to work with diverse groups and individuals to maintain, clean and care for an 11 person bunkhouse. Additional duties include checking visitors and staff in and out of the bunkhouse and may also include grounds care and light maintenance duties at our headquarters and Islands and Ocean Visitor Center. Approximately 24 hours per week are required. No pre training is required; orientation and on the job training will be available if accepted for the position.
