

Are you interested in experiencing the wildlife, habitats, and Native culture of Interior Alaska?

**By volunteering through this program at the Tetlin National Wildlife Refuge,
YOU can make a difference!**

- **Tetlin Visitor Center** – Milepost 1229 (8 miles from US/ Canada border, 90 miles from Tok) is a beautiful log cabin center which offers a spectacular view of the Refuge from its large viewing deck. Inside are new exhibits along with Native arts demonstrations. Visitor Center volunteers help to extend evening hours, provide light maintenance, and lead short trail hikes. Volunteers will also make evening visits to Seaton Recreation Area (approximately 5 miles from the Visitor Center).

We're looking for friendly, energetic couples to help fill two 6 week positions (from June 11 - July 19, 2012 or from July 16 to Aug. 23, 2012). This opportunity is for couples traveling with their RVs trained in visitor services and maintenance. This location has an RV site (up to 60') with accommodations for water, power, and sewer. Volunteers work four days/week for a total 32 hours and are provided with a meals/incidentals allowance (\$31.50/day worked/ person) while working along with a one time travel allowance of up to \$300./ couple. Applicants should have prior experience in communicating with the public, be physically able to lead short hikes on a moderately steep grade, be able to lift and carry up to 30 lbs., possess current CPR and first aid certifications, and have valid driver's licenses. Background checks will be required for these positions. Volunteers will need to work independently & with guidance from staff.
