### Roles of Voting Members:

Roles/Duties of members include participation, whenever possible, in Panel meetings, work groups, and requests via the e-mail listserve for votes or other input. To enhance coordination of activities, members should communicate ANS management and policy initiatives to other Panel members through presentations at the annual meeting or via the e-mail listserve. Members are expected to communicate the Panel’s recommended actions to the organizations they represent, and strive to improve the organization’s ability to address ANS issues.

**Please submit a nomination form for a “Tribal” or “Other Interests” voting position by August 7, 2009.** [If a nomination is not submitted for a position that currently exists or is held, that position could be removed by a Panel vote at the annual meeting.](#) You may nominate another organization for membership, or a topic (e.g. recreational boating) with an organization to be determined if selected.
