There are two private waterfowl hunt clubs within two miles. The walk-in public area lease (Between Clallam county boat ramp and the mouth of the Dungeness river) was not renewed, but there have been hunters using private access in that same general area multiple times last year. Also, any open navigable water is open to public hunting and last year there were 15-20 different groups using the areas adjacent to the refuge closed areas. This activity was mainly observed during the latter part of the season especially during the brant hunt days. Hope this helps.
