Nathan and Jennifer – I know you probably have this letter of agreement in your files but I thought I could just send it out again as part of the record.

This agreement was signed in 1983 and we have been abiding by its terms since then. The language was crafted based on S'Klallam treaty rights to salmon and steelhead which were in place at the time. However, with the shellfish case concluding in 1994 the same principles apply regarding treaty rights and shellfish.

Just something to keep in mind as we prepare for our meeting.
