EPA recently approved label amendments for USDA APHIS' three conservation rodenticide registrations. The approval letters with the stamped labels are attached. They can also be viewed in EPA's [Pesticide Product and Label System database](#). USDA Wildlife Services' state registrations of these labels will be updated shortly.

The primary changes to the labels include:

- All federal agencies responsible for wildlife management are allowed to purchase the product (before, only USDA APHIS, USFWS, and NPS were allowed).
- The First Aid section and Precautionary Statements were updated to be more consistent with labels for similar diphacinone and brodifacoum baits.
- The respirator language on the brodifacoum labels was updated to meet current EPA requirements.
- The instructions for Hand Baiting Applications under the Application Directions section are now presented in a table rather than in paragraphs.
- The bait station and bait bola (sachet) application rates and spacing between bait placements were modified to better target each type of rodent on islands.
- Bait bolas (sachets) may now be thrown or dropped into uninhabited grounded vessels or vessels in peril of grounding that are difficult or unsafe for applicators to enter. Before, only tamper-resistant bait stations were allowed for these use sites.
- The Posttreatment Clean-Up section does not require applicators to retrieve bait stations and bolas in locations that are not safe for applicators to enter or reach.
- The Storage and Disposal section was amended to provide disposal instructions for both plastic and paper containers.
