Hello Team,

I wanted to send out a reminder in this incredibly busy time about the final push to get the DEIS out to the agencies early in November. I am nearly finished incorporating all of the revisions and comments into the draft and have started finalizing the formatting and other aspects of the draft including figures, tables, pictures, section numbers, and appendices. I am still waiting for comments on the final Alternatives Selection Report, and I believe that Russ is still waiting for some comments on the gull PVA and the ASSP power analysis. In addition, I am waiting for comments on the gull risk assessment (Gerry I will send you a copy later this week), so that Stantec can incorporate changes into the report before I insert sections into the EIS. Dan is working to complete the three trial reports from 2010 and 2011, FWS is working to complete the draft biosecurity plan, and PRBO is working to complete the species list and food web. Finally, there are a few loose ends that need to be discussed before finalizing the DEIS including historical resources (from comments received by Barbara Goodyear), estimated gull numbers for the MBTA permit, maps, Wilderness determination, how we have reconciled the major issues raised in our last partner meeting (salamanders and bait degradation), and the final steps to getting the DEIS out to the agencies.

I would like to arrange for us to meet next week and discuss these important issues. Are you available to meet on Monday or Tuesday to discuss these issues? Please send me your availability for next week asap. Thanks,
