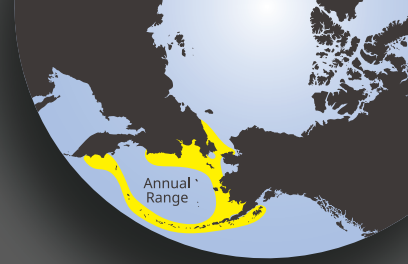

It Takes All of Us to Protect Alaska's Goose

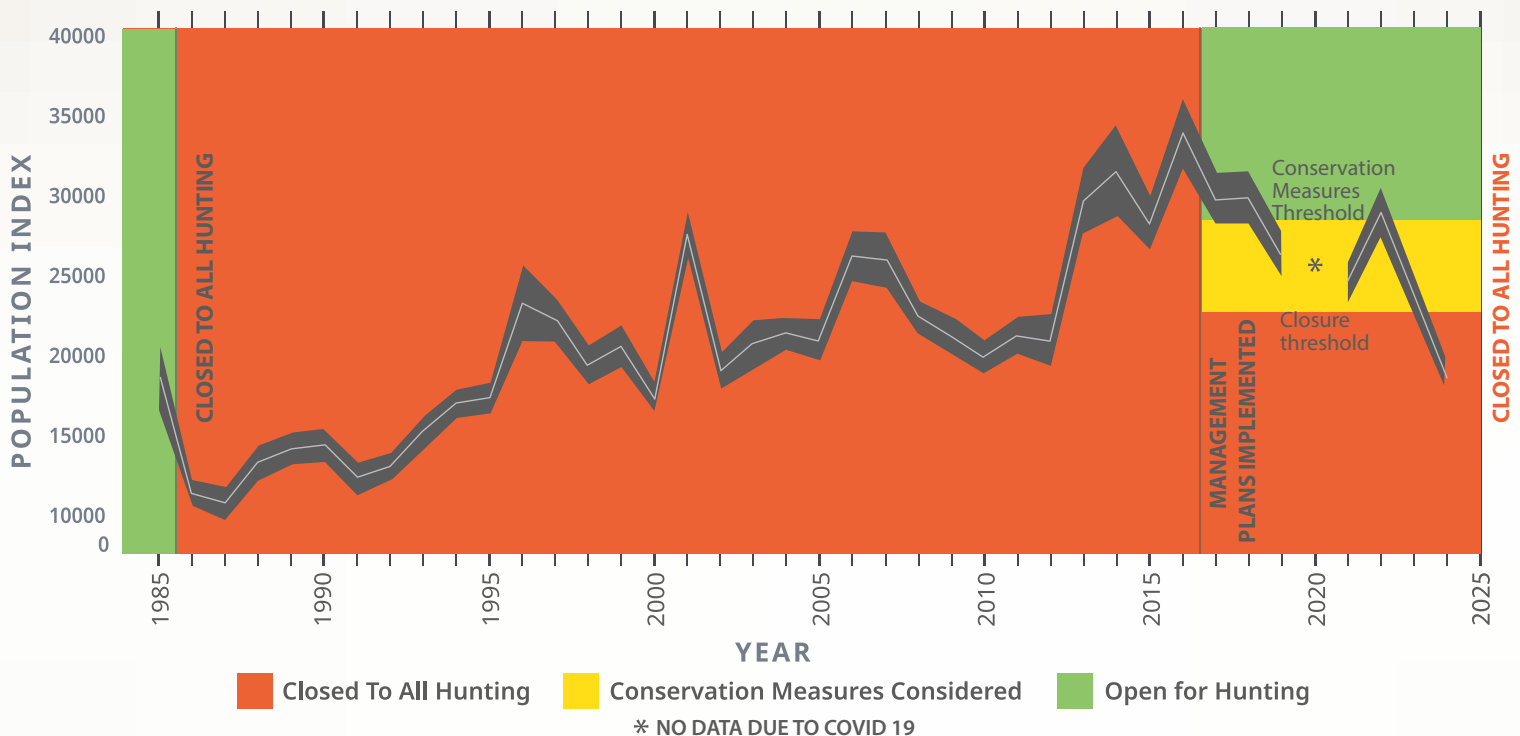

HARVEST CLOSURE

Emperor Geese are closed to ALL harvest (birds and eggs) in 2025 and will remain closed until the population increases to a level where harvest may resume.

This includes the fall and winter season.



Reasons for the decline are complex and include a variety of factors. The life history traits of emperor geese combined with environmental and human-caused pressures makes it harder for emperor goose populations to grow like other goose species in Alaska.

Past sacrifices by hunters worked to increase the emperor goose population. We can work together and do it again.

This closure is in accordance with the Alaska Migratory Bird Co-Management Council and Pacific Flyway Council management plans.
