Colorado Education Standards

Kindergarten:

- To live and grow, animals obtain food they need from plants or other animals, and plants need water and light (*Life Science*)
- Plants and animals meet their needs in their habitats and impact one another, people can prepare for severe weather (*Life Science*).
- Count to 100 by ones and tens (Math)

First grade:

- All animals have external parts that they use to perform daily functions. (*Life Science*)
- Young organisms are very much, but not exactly, like their parents, and also resemble other organisms of the same kind (*Life Science*)
- Count to 120, starting at any number less than 120. (Math)




