

# Trinity River users

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, California Department of Fish and Game, Yurok Tribe, Hoopa Valley Tribe, and U.S. Forest Service will be conducting a salmon spawning survey in the Trinity River from Lewiston Dam to Weitchpec (excluding the Burnt Ranch Gorge) September through December 2010. Surveys will be conducted from rafts. Results of these surveys are used to assess the spawning distribution of natural origin Chinook salmon and their response to restoration actions (gravel introduction, rehabilitation site construction, etc).
