

Meeting Announcement
Trinity River Adaptive Management Working Group
June 10 - 11, 2009
Weaverville, CA

The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group will meet Wednesday, June 10, 2009, from 12 p.m. (noon) to 5 p.m. and Thursday, June 11, 2009, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The meeting which is open to the public will be held at the Trinity County Library, 211 Main St., in Weaverville, CA. The primary objectives of this meeting will include discussion of the following topics: Trinity River Restoration Program structure and Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group/Trinity Management Council/Trinity River Restoration Program relationships; Budget update; Channel rehabilitation program; Reservoir management (Temperature issues, carryover storage, minimum pool criteria); Hatchery goals and practices; Sediment monitoring; Progress towards an Request For Proposal-based science program; and Integrated Information Management System. Completion of the agenda is dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed.
