

*Implementation and Environmental Compliance Update
June 16-17, 2016 TAMWG
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Implementation

- Hocker Flat (revegetation)
 - Initial revegetation efforts completed by Samara Restoration Nursery (3.5 acres planted & irrigated).
 - Final walk thru June 11, 2015.
- Upper Douglas City
 - Contractor is on board. Two preliminary meetings have taken place.
 - Mobilization to site is expected late June or early July.
- Limekiln
 - EA was finalized May 22, 2015.
 - The Yurok Tribe will construct this project this summer.
- Bucktail
 - Moving forward with phased approach and available funding.
 - Hoopa Valley Tribe will construct.
- Lower Dutch Creek
 - US Forest Service is going to re-scope this project very soon. Intent is to have an environmental document out for this project in fall 2015 and to build in 2016.
- Lower Valley Suite (Chapman Ranch, Deep Gulch, and Sheridan Creek)
 - Existing conditions report in review. Minimum requirements for existing condition reporting are under evaluation.
- Value Engineering Study
 - Planned for July 20-24 to evaluate Chapman Ranch, Deep Gulch, and Sheridan Creek designs.
 - The Federal, Hoopa Valley and Yurok Tribe teams are preparing designs and design reports that will be submitted to the VE Team.

Environmental Compliance

- 3 Long-term (5-year) water quality certifications have been renewed by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board. Permits and their renewal dates include:
 - Coarse Sediment Management (April 28, 2015; WDID No. 1A09154WNTR),
 - Fine Sediment Management (April 28; 2015; WDID No. !A)!%%WNTR), and
 - Channel Rehabilitation (May 20, 2015; Order No. R1-2015-0026)
- Permits for construction this summer (U.S. Army Corps & Water Board) are in process.
- The U.S. Forest Service is ready to fly a scoping notice for the Lower Dutch Creek Project. Project Environmental documents are planned for public release this fall.
