Folks,

In lieu of being there, or not having a phone available from which to talk about this agenda item, here are some bullet points that can be shared with the group.

- Long Term Plan - An EIS will be developed for the Long Term Plan. A Notice of Intent is anticipated to be published in the Federal Register in July. Public scoping meeting dates for this summer, etc will be available soon. A press release from USBR will be forthcoming in July.
- 2015 Flow Augmentation - We are working on the environmental review for the potential need to augment flows in 2015. The draft Environmental Assessment is undergoing internal review and refinements with an anticipated public release draft available in early July.
- Central Valley Operations - Water temperature modeling continues to examine the effects of a potential flow augmentation action for the lower Klamath River in 2015. These modeling results will be included in the environmental review. In addition, water temperature modeling and decisions continue to advance to develop a Temperature Management Plan for the Sacramento River system for the Winter Run salmon.
