

**Meeting Announcement**  
**Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group**  
**April 1-2, 2004**  
**Weaverville, CA**

The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group (TAMWG) will meet Thursday, April 1, from 1:00 PM to 5:00 PM and Friday, April 2, 2004 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM at the Weaverville Victorian Inn 1709 Main Street, Weaverville, CA. The primary objectives of this meeting will include: executive director's report, discuss strategic plan for Trinity River Restoration Program, election of officers, TAMWG operations and subcommittees, charter renewal and member appointments, annual flow schedule, program evaluation, and a tentative field trip. The agenda items are approximate and are dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed. The meeting is open to the public.

The TAMWG affords stakeholders the opportunity to give policy, management, and technical input concerning Trinity River restoration efforts to the Trinity Management Council. Members of the working group represent a broad cross-section of organizations that are not otherwise represented on the decision-making Trinity Management Council. These interests include residents of the Trinity River basin, recreational and commercial fishing organizations, Trinity Lake Resort Owners, white water rafters and guides, power utilities, irrigators, small businesses, and forestry associations.
