The Trinity Adaptive Management Working Group (TAMWG) will meet Tuesday, September 12, from 1:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and Wednesday, September 13, from 8:30 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. at the Weaverville Victorian Inn, 1709 Main St., Weaverville, CA 96093. The primary objectives of this meeting will include: Trinity River Restoration Program budget for 2007; TAMWG Charter renewal; Klamath River conditions and Klamath-Trinity management corporation; restoration experience on Clear Creek; science framework; Executive Director's report; reports from Trinity River Restoration Program workgroups; and Central Valley Project Improvement Act (CVPIA) program review. The agenda items are approximate and are dependent on the amount of time each item takes. The meeting could end early if the agenda has been completed. The meeting is open to the public.
