You will soon get an email from ACE discussing the process for Sect. 106 effects review for the an aquaculture project at DNWR that is being proposed by the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe. The project application has not yet been submitted to ACE.

I wanted to let you know that Kevin F. and the regional solicitor have made it clear to ACE that FWS will not, and cannot, take federal lead on this project. Kevin also told ACE that we expect to work with them throughout the process to ensure that the inventory and effects analysis meet our needs. It is my understanding that ACE has let the applicant know that they are responsible for conducting the cultural resources inventory following SHPO requirements.

Just didn't want you to walk into the situation blind and end up committing to something outside of what the Region has agreed to.
