Charlie let me know that you are taking the first bite of the apple on this CD. To help get you started, I have attached some documents describing the requested activity.

Based on communication with Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe, it is our understanding the ACE permit is based on the attached operational plan. The ACE and County Permit decision documents are also attached. The work windows described in the attached operation plan were based on our original 2018 comment to Clallam County, however this timing was amended in the USFWS May 22, 2019 comment (based on additional migration information).

As you may have gleaned from the comments I forwarded previously, this activity would be located in the highest use area for shorebirds and wildlife on the Refuge (also important locally, regionally and internationally). And, access is requested during the time that the area is closed to all public uses (Oct 1 - May 14), as described in the DNGNWR CCP and associated CDs.

Do you have MS Teams? It might be helpful to add you to the Aquaculture Team that has been created so I can more easily share documents (e.g., other DNGNWR CDs and comment references).

As you start to dive in, let me know what other information you might need, and feel free to call anytime.
