Saranac (Zone 2) Lake Water-Use Advisory Area

All residents within the advisory zone have been contacted in advance and their water use needs have been accommodated.

Advisory zone public access sites are posted while the advisory is in effect.

The New York State and Vermont Departments of Health advise that the water in the advisory area **NOT BE USED** for **DRINKING, DOMESTIC USE, FISHING, SWIMMING, IRRIGATION, or LIVESTOCK WATERING** while in effect.

Citizens not located within the advisory zone are not subjected to the advisory.
