- Makes irregularly shaped mounds out of well processed soil

- Lives in variety of soils types
- Makes round, uniform mounds out of clumpy unworked soil

Little Mound on the Prairie

Gopher and mole mounds can be hard to tell apart, especially when found in the same place. Sometimes it takes a trained expert to know what clues to look for, including the mound shape and soil condition.

Mazama pocket gophers are found in well-drained soils. like those found in Thurston and Pierce County prairies.

Moles, which are also found in prairies, can occupy a much wider variety of soils.
