About the Document

Title: Draft Recovery Plan for Clarkia imbricata (Vine Hill Clarkia)

Subject and Purpose: This document presents a program for the recovery of Vine Hill clarkia, including measurable and objective criteria and those actions necessary for achieving recovery, as well as addressing two species of concern, Vine Hill manzanita and Vine Hill ceanothus.

About the Peer Review Process

Type of review: Letter.

Number of reviewers: We received peer review from one expert in October, 2015.

Reviewer Expertise: Primary expertise for the review is familiarity with the life history, threats, and habitat requirements of Vine Hill clarkia, manzanita and ceanothus.

Selection of Peer Reviewer: The Service selected peer reviewers based on their expertise with the subject matter and lack of any conflicts of interest as described in the Office of Management Peer Review Guidelines.

Management of Peer Review: The peer review was managed by the Service.

Estimated Start Date of Peer Review: July 2015.
