Sabrina: I tried e-mailing the conflict of interest page, but have not been able to do so. I have no conflicts, but if you still need the form, I can mail it.

As for the document, I have only a few comments, none of them amounting to anything significant but rather clarification. I am not including any editing corrections that will need to be addressed in the future.

Page 1: change "medium sized" to "small sized"

change "Baja California" to "northwestern Baja California"

Page 3-4: maintain the same order of "resiliency, redundancy, and representation"

Page 12: under "B" change "rearing" to "captive rearing"

Page 13: change "In-Vitro" to "captive rearing"

Page 14: change "Baja California" to northwestern Baja California

clarification - Hermes was collected (by me) within about 1/4 mile or less from ocean on a slope both east and west of the toll road near Salsipuedes, northwestern Baja California. That was the farthest west that I have records of from Mexico. Hermes appears to be uncommon in Mexico and many attempts were made to find populations in suitable habitat and during the flight season. Obviously, more work needs to be done.

Everything else in the document appears to be correct. Let me know if you need anything else.
