


The day will be broken into stations. The time spent at each station will depend on the number of participants in the camp.

OPENING - The U.S. Army Corp of Engineers will teach water safety to youth.




The adults will meet with the Friends of Dale Hollow National Fish Hatchery to better understand what we are trying to do.


