


See the Refuge in a New Way!

At least one of your photos will be displayed for a limited time on the photo frame in the Visitor Center. Please return with friends or family to “visit” your photo soon. There are multiple scavenger hunts available, so please return for more scavenger hunt adventures!

We encourage you to continue your photographic explorations of nature after you leave the refuge. Visit www.fws.gov/deerflat to download additional scavenger hunts. Whether you look in your backyard, neighborhood, or anywhere, you are bound to find many interesting things!

1. Two different types of grass in the same photo.
2. A bird whose call says its name, like Killdeer.
3. A hummingbird.
4. A plant whose name makes you think of the Fourth of July.
5. A serrated leaf.
6. An animal without a backbone.
7. Animal or bird POOP! Can you tell what animal or bird it's from? NO credit for dog poop.
8. Animal tracks.
9. A native plant. What are its adaptations to Idaho?
10. A non-native plant. How does it survive in Idaho?
11. Yellow pollen in the center of a flower.
12. Something people have done that helps wildlife.
13. Something that changes the color of the bark of a shrub or tree by growing on it.
14. Varying shades—three items that are different shades of green in one photo.
15. Something you have never seen before.
