


See the Refuge in a New Way!

Welcome to Deer Flat National Wildlife Refuge and the photo scavenger hunt! During your hunt, try to get at least one photo for each category below. There is no “correct answer,” so feel free to interpret the categories broadly.



At least one of your photos will be displayed for a limited time on the photo frame in the Visitor Center. Please return with friends or family to “visit” your photo soon. There are multiple scavenger hunts available, so please return for more scavenger hunt adventures!

We encourage you to continue your photographic explorations of nature after you leave the refuge. Visit www.fws.gov/deerflat to download additional scavenger hunts. Whether you look in your backyard, neighborhood, or anywhere, you are bound to find many interesting things!

1. Use shallow depth of field
2. Use wide angle to create an interesting or funny effect
3. Use intentional blur in a creative way
4. Use a deep depth of field
5. Compose a photo using dynamic balance
6. Shoot a photo using soft light
7. Shoot a photo using hard light
8. Shoot a photo using back light
9. Shoot a subject influenced by reflected color
10. Shoot a composition using clear figure and ground
11. Shoot a subject dominated by cool light
12. Shoot a subject dominated by warm light
13. Emphasize 3D over 2D in a composition
14. Shoot a subject with saturated colors
15. Shoot a subject with monochromatic colors
16. Use shutter speed to create an interesting effect
17. A reflection (not in a mirror)
