Deer Flat National Wildlife Refuge Public Comment Update

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) completed the first public comment period for the Deer Flat National Wildlife Refuge (NWR) Comprehensive Conservation Plan (CCP) on September 10, 2010. The 58-day comment period provided the public an opportunity to identify issues that should be considered in the plan, as well as to participate in work sessions. Summaries of the public input and the work sessions are available on the Refuge website. In addition, Planning Update 2, which summarizes the issues identified by the public during the public comment period, has been mailed to individuals that are on our mailing list. Anyone not on the CCP mailing list can download a copy from the Refuge website or pick up a copy at the Refuge Visitor Center.

Additional opportunities to provide comments and feedback to the Refuge will occur in early Summer 2011 and Spring 2012, as draft documents are completed and made available for public review.
