Your request, dated April 7, 2011, to rebuild Sea Rim State Park by discharging 632 cubic yards of fill material into 0.61 acres of jurisdictional waters is approved pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act and Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899. The repair of Sea Rim State Park involves installing pavement for parking spaces, constructing restroom facilities, recreational vehicle and tent camping sites, comfort stations, showers, beach access roads and boardwalks, a visitor's center and extending a 2,700 linear-foot 8-inch water line. The project site is located in jurisdictional areas within the Sea Rim State Park near Sabine Pass in Jefferson County, Texas.

#### Conditions for Letter of Permission:

#### General Conditions:

- The time limit for completing the activity authorized ends on 31 December 2016. If you find that you need more
  time to complete the authorized activity, submit your request for a time extension to this office for consideration at
  least one month before the above date is reached.
- 2. You must maintain the activity authorized by this permit in good condition and in conformance with the terms and conditions of this permit. You are not relieved of this requirement if you abandon the permitted activity, although you may make a good faith transfer to a third party in compliance with General Condition 4 below. Should you wish to cease to maintain the authorized activity or should you desire to abandon it without a good faith transfer, you must obtain a modification of this permit from this office, which may require restoration of the area.
- 3. If you discover any previously unknown historic or archeological remains while accomplishing the activity authorized by this permit, you must immediately notify this office of what you have found. We will initiate the Federal and state coordination required to determine if the remains warrant a recovery effort or if the site is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.
- 4. If you sell the property associated with this permit, you must obtain the signature of the new owner in the space provided and forward a copy of the permit to this office to validate the transfer of this authorization.
- If a conditioned water quality certification has been issued for your project, you must comply with the conditions specified in the certification as special conditions to this permit. For your convenience, a copy of the certification is attached if it contains such conditions.
- 6. You must allow representatives from this office to inspect the authorized activity at any time deemed necessary to ensure that it is being or has been accomplished in accordance with the terms and conditions of your permit.

#### Special Conditions:

- 1. - d. This permit does not authorize interference with any existing or proposed Federal project.
- 3. Limits of Federal Liability. In issuing this permit, the Federal Government does not assume any liability for the following:
  - Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of other permitted or unpermitted activities
    or from natural causes.
  - Damages to the permitted project or uses thereof as a result of current or future activities undertaken by or on behalf of the United States in the public interest.
  - Damages to persons, property or to other permitted or unpermitted activities or structures caused by the
    activity authorized by this permit.
  - Design or construction deficiencies associated with the permitted work.
  - Damage claims associated with any future modification, suspension or revocation of this permit.
- Reliance on Applicant's Data: The determination of this office that issuance of this permit is not contrary to the
  public interest was made in reliance on the information you provided.
- Reevaluation of Permit Decision: This office may reevaluate its decision on this permit at any time the
  circumstances warrant. Circumstances that could require a reevaluation include, but are not limited to, the
  following:
  - a. You fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this permit.
  - b. The information provided by you in support of your permit application proves to have been false, incomplete or inaccurate (See 4 above).
  - Significant new information surfaces which this office did not consider in reaching the original public interest decision.

Such a reevaluation may result in a determination that it in appropriate to use the suspension, modification and revocation procedures contained in 33 CFR 325.7 or enforcement procedures such as those contained in 33 CFR 326.4 and 326.5. The referenced enforcement procedures provide for the issuance of an administrative order requiring you to comply with the terms and conditions of your permit and for the initiation of legal action where appropriate.
