I'm following up on our conference call we had about the Deer Island subtidal reef project. We have no objections or specific concerns regarding issuance of a Corp permit for this project.

We did an ESA Section 7 consultation on this project with our NRDAR office in 2015. We concluded at that time that the proposed project "may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect" the piping plover, red knot, and West Indian manatee, and will have "no effect" on the Alabama red-bellied turtle (see attachments). The project was modified last year (see attachment) and we concurred via email below that the changes were consistent with our initial consultation.

We encourage you to use the findings from these previous consultations to fulfill the Corps obligations under Section 7 of the ESA.
