Thank you for your letter dated December 2, 2016, regarding a Coastal Barrier Resource Act (CBRA) determination for the DWH Early Restoration Project Alternatives in Coastal Alabama. Your letter is requesting that the Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) determine whether the proposed alternatives are located within the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resource System (CBRS) and if so, whether the project is consistent with the Coastal Barrier Resource Act (CBRA) of 1982. The Service has reviewed the proposed alternatives and provides the following information on a technical assistance basis.

Project Alternatives:

- 1) Gulf State Park Lodge and Associated Public Access Amenities
- 2) Fort Morgan Pier Rehabilitation

Project Alternatives:


- 3) Fort Morgan Peninsula Public Access Improvements
