

SUBJECT: LA TIG RP/EA #3.3: No Further MMPA Evaluation Needed for the Large-Scale Barataria Marsh Creation: Upper Barataria Component

Based on my review of project materials including the Biological Evaluation form (January 2020) the NOAA Restoration Center (RC) determined that the Large-Scale Barataria Marsh Creation: Upper Barataria Component project will not require further evaluation under the the Marine Mammal Project Act (MMPA). Representatives from NOAA's Protected Resources Division in the Southeast Regional Office provided technical assistance on this project. Appropriate measures and best management practices were included in the BE forms and will be implemented to avoid and minimize effects marine mammals, thus consultations and permits under MMPA are not required.

If the project is modified in a way that could change these determinations it will be reevaluated as appropriate.
