Subject: No Coastal Barrier Restoration Act (CBRA) Consistency Determination Required for Eleven (11) Projects in Florida Trustee Implementation Group's (FL TIG) Restoration Plan #2: Habitat Projects on Federal Managed Lands; Sea Turtles; Birds; and Provide and Enhance Recreational Opportunities

We used the Coastal Barrier Resources System mapper – Beta (<https://www.fws.gov/cbra/maps/mapper.html> [accessed October 1, 2021]) to determine if eleven (11) proposed actions associated with Florida Trustee Implementation Group's (FL TIG) Restoration Plan #2: Habitat Projects on Federal Managed Lands; Sea Turtles; Birds; and Provide and Enhance Recreational Opportunities are located within an Otherwise Protected Area (OPA) or within a System Unit (CBRS). If the proposed action occurs in an OPA or outside of a System Unit, no additional analysis was developed. These projects are listed below in Table 1.
