From the Deepwater Horizon (MC 252) Oil Spill (Bird Study #4)

This Amendment to the Work Plan for Estimating Oiling and Mortality of Breeding Colonial Waterbirds From the Deepwater Horizon (MC 252) Oil Spill (Bird Study #4) ("the CWB Work Plan") provides for an additional 1.5 months of field capture efforts, 3 months of tracking, and 2 months of data workup. The budget for this Amendment is \$1,644,368.

The Parties acknowledge that this budget is an estimate, and that actual costs may prove to be higher. BP's commitment to fund the costs of this work includes any additional reasonable costs within the scope of this approved work plan that may arise. The trustees will make a good faith effort to notify BP in advance of any such increased costs.


