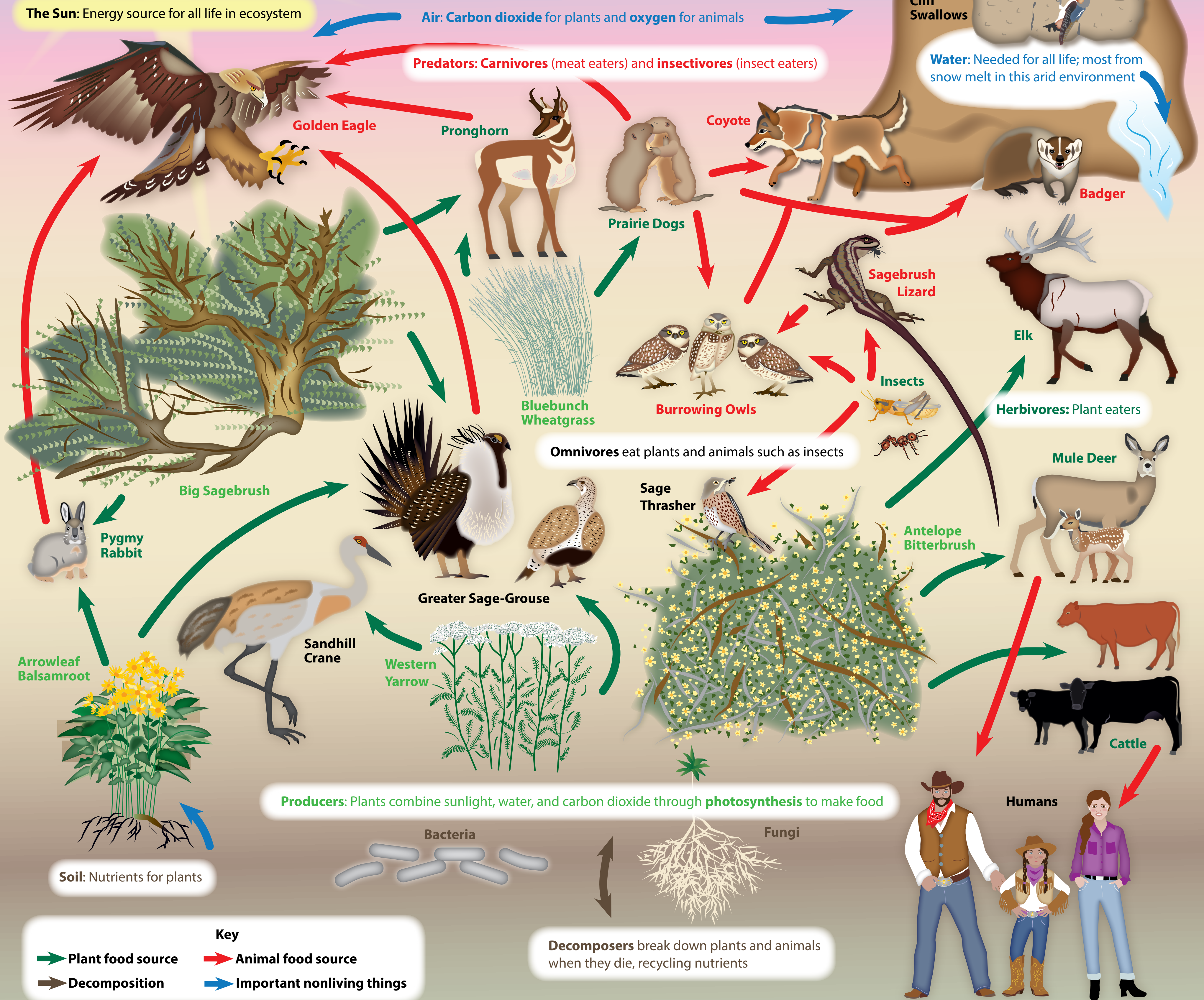




# SAGEBRUSH ECOSYSTEMS

More than 350 species call the sagebrush ecosystem home. All are linked together in a food web, starting when plants make food from sunlight. Each species is adapted to survive with little water during hot, dry summers and cold winters.
