Action abbreviations are as follows: 12M = 12-month petition finding; PLPCH = proposed listing (if warranted) and proposed critical habitat (if prudent and determinable), if listing is warranted and proposed rule is promulgated, USFWS follows the statutory deadlines for final rules; FL = final listing determination which may result in the species being added to the list of endangered or threatened species or withdrawn from proposal if the species no longer meets the definition of an endangered or threatened species.

Date = Fiscal Year within which a finding or rule is scheduled to be submitted to the Federal Register for publication. Click on the species common name and then on the Federal Register link on the associated species page to determine whether an action has been submitted to the Federal Register and the date of its publication. The target date for a final rule is one year after publication of the proposal. Dates that are labeled in ***bold red italics*** are stipulated in the MDL agreement or another court settlement agreement.
