



To help pollinators you can...



Plant native flowering plants.



Provide habitat for nesting.



Encourage beneficial insects for natural pest control.

What you can do for pollinators in your garden:

Use native flowering plants:

- Choose a variety of colors and shapes
- Choose plants that flower at different times
- Plant the same species in clumps

Provide habitat for nesting, such as:

- Shrubs, tall grasses, and low growing plants
- Patches of fallen branches and brush
- Small patches of bare ground
- Bee nesting blocks

Encourage beneficial insects for natural pest control:

- Provide a variety of plant sizes, heights, and types
- Expect and accept a little bit of pest activity
- Minimize the use of pesticides
