36" width x 12" height

Printing Resizing Options: % of actual size, ranging 100% to 300% -- your choice, however you like.

100% = 36"w x 12"h

200% = 72"w x 24"h

300% = 108"w x 36"h

Instruction for printing: Having your banner printed can be easy to do. Download the files onto a thumb drive and take it to a local printing shop such as Staples, Office Depot, FedEx Office or The UPS Store. You can also go to their website, if they provide that option, and upload the files there. Be sure to include type of paper and print size. Let them know about blow up the scaling (from custom layout size to banner size).
