BIRD WALK from 7:30 am Meet at the Duncan Memorial Trail. Spring migration is a great time to see various birds as former manager, Jim Krakowski leads a birding tour around our public trail. <Easy walking tour for 2.5 hours>

SWAMP BUGGY TOUR 8, 8:45, 9:15, 10, 10:30, 11, & 11:30 The 60 minute buggy tours are scheduled to depart the Roger Roth Work Center & will go thru cypress swamps and oak hammocks where you will feel a sense of wilderness – Natural Florida. **(full)**



NATIVE PLANT ID WALKS WITH BIOLOGIST MIKE BARRY 8:45 & 10:45am Visitors can participate in 1.5hr plant identification walks to learn about plant ecology in a tropical hammock. Mike Barry has been a plant biologist and ecologist in the area for over 10 yrs, watching ecosystem global changes. He will relate saving endangered individual species to the big picture for conservation.

SWAMP WALK ORCHID TOURS WITH DENNIS GIARDINA 8:30, 10 & 11:30am Tours will take visitors through beautiful swamp (you'll get your feet wet) so gear up and check out the special & rare orchids that make the Refuge their home! **(full)**

PHOTO WORKSHOP WITH LARRY RICHARDSON 9am– 12pm Meet at the Roger Roth Work Center for a hands-on workshop that will cover the basics and offer tips from experienced photographers. Be prepared to get your feet wet and to capture a beautiful swamp!
