

CCC ON REFUGES

LOCATION: Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge, UT

DATES: Established as a National Wildlife Refuge in 1928 as suitable refuge, feeding and breeding grounds for migratory wild fowl. CCC present in early 1940s.

ACTIVITIES: Most of the construction on site is the work of the CCC including an extensive canal system, administration building, duck hospital, garage, observation tower, dikes, and two residences.
