

CCC ON REFUGES

LOCATION: J. Clark Salyer National Wildlife Refuge, previously Lower Souris National Wildlife Refuge, ND

DATES: Established as a National Wildlife Refuge on September 4, 1935 as an important feeding and resting area for hundreds of thousands of waterfowl. CCC present during the mid-1930's.

ACTIVITIES: The CCC built a series of low dikes and water control structures along the Souris River, and planted aquatic plants to enhance marsh development.
