

National Wildlife Refuge System Lighthouses

More than two dozen lighthouses stand on U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service land managed by national wildlife refuges. Another half-dozen are often associated with a refuge but are not on U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service land. All can be seen from the outside; the inside of some is open to limited public visitation. Check with individual refuges for details. Most websites listed are unofficial, non-U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service sites.
