

CCC ON REFUGES

LOCATION: Squaw Creek National Wildlife
Refuge, MO

DATES: Established as a National Wildlife
Refuge in 1935 as a resting, feeding,
and breeding ground for migratory
birds and other wildlife. CCC present
from July 1935 to December 1936.

ACTIVITIES: The CCC built fish shelters, nesting
islands, and major spillways, and
crushed stone in local quarries to
build walkways up Lookout
Mountain.
