

CCC ON REFUGES

LOCATION: St. Marks National Wildlife Refuge,
FL

DATES: Established as a National Wildlife
Refuge in 1931 as one of the few
African American camps in the CCC.
CCC present from 1934 to early
1940s.

ACTIVITIES: The CCC constructed roads, miles of
earthen levees, and impoundments,
erected telephone poles, strung
power and telephone lines, raised
fences, and built dwellings.
