## Federal Ducks Stamps

The Perfect Holiday Gift That Keeps on Giving

Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamps, commonly known as “duck stamps,” were originally created in 1934 as the federal licenses required for hunting migratory waterfowl. Today, the Federal Duck Stamp is considered a vital tool for wetland conservation, and for this, and several other good reasons, it is the perfect holiday gift...

■ **Easy to Buy:** You can buy them at your local post office, many major sporting goods stores, through the mail and online.



■ **Easy to Wrap:** Use that left over piece of wrapping paper from the last gift you wrapped – duck stamps are not bulky – no box required.

■ **Easy to ship:** A trip to the local post office or other shipping company is not necessary – just put in an envelope and drop in any mailbox.

■ **Very Inexpensive:** When's the last time you purchased a meaningful gift that cost only \$15 (or \$5 for the junior duck stamp)?

■ **Helps Conserve and Protect Our Wildlife:** The lands purchased with revenue generated by the sell of duck stamps provide critical habitat for ducks, geese and other wildlife.



■ **An Investment for Our Children:** The habitat that is conserved will ensure a place for our children to get back to nature and spend quality time outdoors hiking, bird watching, or simply enjoying the wilderness.

■ **A Wise Investment:** 98 cents of every dollar of the duck stamp program revenue goes directly to purchasing wetland habitat for the National Wildlife Refuge System.
