1. Description of Idea:

A summary of your idea/design/concept in 400 words or fewer.

2. Educational Component:

An explanation of how your idea/design will work to inform and educate the public and encourage people to take action to reduce ivory demand and stop illegal wildlife trade.

3. Rough Production Timing and Costs:

Brief explanation of the method of production, along with an estimate of timing and production costs.

NOTE: If you are unsure of the production methods, timing and costs, that's OK – provide us your best estimate.

4. Pictures/Illustrations/Renderings:

An opportunity to visually bring your idea to life with sketches, drawings, renderings, etc.
