



I the undersigned certify that to the best of knowledge and belief that the above client's game trophies as per Annexure attached:

1. The skins have been through a complete Tanning Process.

The first stage of processing is submerging the skin in a mixture of water, salt, a chemical known as RR502, which is a relaxing agent, and a bactericide; this is to rehydrate the skin. Phenol carbolic crystals are added to the above mixture.

The skins are submerged in this mixture for a period of 24 hours. It is then removed from this mixture, rinsed and added to a tanning pickle consisting of salt and formic acid, mixed to an acidic PH of 1.8.

During this process, the skin is shaved until it is thin enough to handle.
The skin is removed and placed in a Chrome Tanning agent.
The skins have been completely processed, and are free of any bacterial matter.

2. Skull & Horns has been through the following process:

Have been in boiling water for an appropriate time so as to ensure that any matter other than bone, horns, hooves, claws, antlers or teeth is removed. Have been disinfected with a product authorized by the competent authority in the country of dispatch, in particular with hydrogen peroxide when parts consisting of bone are concerned.

1. Soaking in boiling water for a minimum of 2 hours;
2. Soaking in a 5% hydrogen peroxide for a minimum of 2 hours
