Hunting and Lion observation report for Timothy Ross Fallon, Tanzania Oct 2017.

Tanzania Game Tracker Safaris, LTD. Maswa Kimali Game Reserve, Simiyu Tanzania

1. **Attach copy of your Hunting Permit. Please see attached.**

2. **What was your experience and observation before the hunt?** This was my 27th Safari to Africa so I have had extensive experience throughout the continent. This was the largest hunt I had ever done and was very excited about it because it was in the Friedkin Foundation concessions in Tanzania <http://friedkinfund.org/>. Long known for massive amounts of wildlife and great community projects throughout many parts of Tanzania. I had always heard many wonderful things about how well the areas were managed. What I witnessed in the two of the concessions owned by the foundation was an amazing experience, none like I had ever seen before in Africa or anywhere else in the world. The massive amounts of game we saw was breathtaking. The anti-poaching programs in place as well as the involvement in the local communities in preserving the wildlife was simply the best I had ever seen, and it was working! We literally saw thousands of game species daily, including hundreds of elephants, thousands of buffalo, leopards during the middle of the day and lions like I have never seen before, literally hundreds daily. And, that does even begin to count the antelope species which were so numerous it was impossible to count.

3. **What was your experience during the hunt and how many lion, elephant or leopard did you see?** See above. It was difficult to count the Leopards as perhaps in the 21 days we were there, we saw 10+ different leopards which is extremely unusual during the day. The lions were literally everywhere in the huge area we hunted. One day alone we counted more than 125 different lions including one male pride of over 8 male lions ranging in ages from 5 years old and several much older. We never saw less than 2 family prides in any single day and many days saw 5 prides with the average pride being around 15 to 20 including cubs.



4. **What was your experience after the hunt and what resulted in the community because of the hunt?** The two concessions we hunted were employing an average of 50-75 locals for camp staff, trackers, drivers and maintenance folks. The amount of local employment by just one camp was amazing! The local villages received all the meat from the trophies as well as much support in terms of wells, healthcare and school facilities. I was very impressed with the way they hunted their game species, especially the lion. We only hunted lions in old bachelor groups usually containing 2 to 3 older lions which were always found stalking buffalo herds in the hundreds. There were at least 2 lions we saw that we knew would be well about 6 to 7 years old in the bachelor groups. If there were any family prides in the area, we immediately departed the area and kept hunting for another older Bachelor group. All the hunting was done on foot and vehicles were used to transition from one area to another.


5. **What was the amount paid in licenses and trophy fees and how were these funds used by the government, community and/or land owner to benefit conservation to the species being hunted.** This hunt alone was more than \$200,000 all-inclusive for government fees, daily fees, licenses, charters and trophy fees. Of that, the Tanzania Government received 40% for licenses and trophy fees. The balance went to charters and daily fees to pay for labor and expenses. These expenses include water restoration and maintenance within the concession area and massive amounts of Anti-Poaching. The Government of Tanzania provides Game Scouts for each of the outfitter's camps throughout the concessions and there was 10 Tanzania Game Scouts alone between the two concession areas we hunted.

Update: In 2019, it was decided to ship my Lion Trophy to South Africa for tanning and preservation. My Leopard Cites Import Permit was issued in 2018 and was shipped to the USA to my Taxidermist along with my other capes.



B. HEALTH ATTESTATION

I, DR. JAMES WARIGBA, the undersigned veterinarian, authorised thereto by the Veterinary Authority of the country of origin, certify that the product described in section A:

1. All trophies were sourced in the exporting country.
2. Hides and skins of all species have been dry or wet salted with sea salt containing 2% washing soda (sodium carbonate) for a minimum of 28 days prior to dispatch. In the case of warthog trophies, the skins were treated with an appropriate acaricide to ensure that no parasites are present on the trophy.
3. Skulls, bone, hooves, claws, teeth and horns of all species (where applicable) were boiled in water for an appropriate time under official veterinary supervision to ensure that any matter other than bone, horns, hooves, claws, antlers or teeth is removed and were disinfected with a product authorized by the veterinary authority. Where bone is present, that must be disinfected with hydrogen peroxide, or soaked in 4% formalin or 5% washing soda, for 48 hours under official veterinary supervision.
4. The trophies originate from an area in which anthrax is not prevalent.

OR

The trophies have been disinfected by fumigation with ethylene oxide 500 mg/m³ at relative humidity 20-40% at 55°C for 30 minutes, or fumigation with formaldehyde 400 mg/m³ at relative humidity 30 %, at 15°C for 4 hours, or gamma irradiation with a dose of 40 kiloGray.

5. The trophies have not been exposed to contamination after treatment.
6. The trophies have been individually wrapped in transparent packaging.


