


# Buck Identification

Antlers good, but not always reliable



Forking upward

Dark forehead

Rising out of main beam

Often long brow tine

White around eyes

May have collar or tags

# Doe Identification


Black tail. Can be cocked out when relaxed

Less white on face


White around eyes and above nose

Longer, wider tail. Usually brown (sometimes with black). Can be tucked when relaxed

May have collars or tags

# Variation Exists - Use More than One Field Mark



Black-tailed Deer: This antler swoops forward and rises out of main beam

White-tailed Deer: This antler looks forked

White-tailed Deer: Tail is thin with black at the tip
