**Monthly Report: May 2007**

**Fish on hand at months end:**

**Rainbow Trout** (BY 06 Spokane Stock –Jumbo Triploid Program) Fingerling on hand at months end are: 4,766 @ 67 fpp. Monthly mortality totaled 7 fish.

**Rainbow Trout** (BY 05 Spokane Stock -Jumbo Program) Jumbo's on hand at months end are: 0 fish. 332 jumbos were stocked into local lakes during the month.

**Rainbow Trout** (BY 06 Spokane Stock –Catchable Triploid Program) Fry on hand at months end are: 160,476 @ 187 fpp. Monthly mortality totaled 149 fry.

**Rainbow Trout** (BY 05 Spokane Stock –Catchable Program) Catchables on hand at months end are: 27,285 @ 3.3 fpp. Monthly mortality totaled 71 fish. 52,298 catchables were stocked into local lakes during the month.

**Rainbow Trout** (BY 06 Kamloops Stock – Triploid Program) Fry on hand at months end are: 53,229 @ 162 fpp. Monthly mortality totaled 39 fry.

**Trapping** to date: (Tucannon River Intake) BY 2007: (20) Spring Chinook Hatchery origin, (35) Spring Chinook Natural origin, and (20) Bull Trout.

**General:** Staff participated projects / routine maintenance items include; Basement egress window project for residence one, cleaned out oil water separator at fueling slab, Doug attended fish food summit meeting in Olympia, replaced interior doors & locks in residence one, and applying pesticides to noxious weeds.
