

Allen Lane is a fish biologist with the Great Lakes Fish Tag and Recovery Laboratory. His primary duties are to operate and maintain automated marking and coded-wire tagging trailers valued at over \$1.4 million each. These trailers are used to tag and mark up to 10 million salmon and trout annually at state and federal hatcheries. He also maintains the program's vehicle fleet along with assisting with lab work such as tag extraction and reading, data entry, and analysis of data recovered tagged fish to support fisheries management. Allen has over 16 years of fisheries experience; 8 years with trout stream restoration for the Wisconsin Department Natural Resources, the Wyoming Game and Fish Department, and Wisconsin Lake and Pond Resources.
