

Kevin Pankow is a Fish Biologist with the Great Lakes Fish Tag and Recovery Laboratory. He has been involved with multiple facets of the program since 2011. His primary duty is directing seasonal technicians with data recovery from tagged and wild fish on the salmon and trout fishery on the Lakes Michigan and Huron. This involves training and guiding staff on field recoveries, data management, lab duties that include tag extraction and reading and fish aging, and coordination of recovery efforts with four state agencies. He also operates and maintains automated mass marking trailers that tag and mark ~10 million trout and salmon at state and federal hatcheries annually. In addition, he assists with field and CWT data management and data analysis projects. He has 12 years of fisheries experience, with six years in fisheries management of inland lakes and streams working for the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
