

Steven “Dale” Hanson has worked as a fisheries biologist in the Native Species unit at Green Bay FWCO since 2002 and previously worked with fisheries in the Atlantic Maritime and Pacific Northwest regions. Dale coordinates wide-ranging field surveys to generate indices of abundance and population age structure for stock assessments, while winter surveys are aimed at the collection of wild deep-water cisco gametes for reintroduction efforts. He also conducts hydro acoustic and midwater trawl assessments in Lake Michigan with an emphasis on estimating prey fish and *Coregonus spp* abundance in Green Bay. Given the number of fish handled each year, he has a keen interest in applied research evaluating existing and novel age subsampling methods.
